

# Kim D. Janda, PhD

Dr. Kim D. Janda is the Ely R. Callaway, Jr. Chaired Professor in the Departments of Chemistry, Immunology and Microbial Science at The Scripps Research Institute and is the Director of the Worm Institute of Research and Medicine. He is well known for his bridging of the fields of chemistry and immunology. Working at this interface he has shown how antibodies could be transformed from simple binding entities to catalysts. He pioneered treating drug addiction through immunopharmacotherapy, the creation of synthetic diversity methods, including phage display, and small molecule DNA encoding methodologies. He has published over 550 peer-reviewed papers.
