

Frank Zerbib, MD

Frank Zerbib is professor of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at the Bordeaux University. He trained in gastroenterology in Bordeaux and graduated in 1992. He received a doctorate in 1999 from Nantes University for research work performed there in Pr JP Galmiche's laboratory. He was appointed as Professor of Gastroenterology in 2002 and head of the Digestive Diseases department at Saint André University Hospital of Bordeaux in 2007. This department moved to Haut Lévêque University Hospital in April 2016 where Pr Zerbib is now working in the gastroenterology unit with Pr Laharie and team. He is the former General Secretary of the French Society of Gastroenterology (SNFGE) and currently president of the Board of physicians in Hepatology and Gastroenterology.

His main research topics are esophageal motility disorders and gastro-esophageal reflux disease and pathophysiology of gastro-esophageal junction. Pr Zerbib has a long-lasting experience in GI endoscopy, functional GI disorders and IBD in both clinical practice and clinical studies.
